As Scott has said, the wait and see attitude will cost us in the end. This new effort by the group of four should be applauded. They will need more than worker support, they will need encouragement to seek change and take risks to make the racing affordable and enjoyable. No one will know of the effort if no one knows what's happening at the track. the motorcycle road racers let people into the events and charge them 5 or 6 bucks to watch, we should do the same at our events. These people would turn into converts, participants and workers if they knew it was there.

We may not agree on some of the risks and other issues, but to put together better racing and a major facility, it will require not only workers, but racers and sponsors and spectators as well. Will we have any??? In my opinion, not until we are willing to look at the whole program and decide to make certain decisions based on size, timing and growth.
