New Rules for April Event

Starting with the April event, the 1984 SCCA Solo II Rules will apply. Besides shifting some cars from one class to another, there are going to be some IMPORTANT changes. First, the single fastest time of the four runs will determine the winners, not the two best times. Second, if you go off the course (that is, you miss a gate), you must re-enter the course from your point of exit. If you do not re-enter, it is a DNF. Third, there will be some new classes—A street prepared, B street prepared, etc. We hope to have a number of sets of rule books at the April event so you can see if you want to race in any of these new classes.

The Solo II events will always be on the second Sunday of the month (except for December, when there will be no Solo II event). Unless stated otherwise, all SCCA racing events will be held at Aloha Stadium.
