

### Step 1 -- Register/Check in @ GATE

- a. Complete walk-up registration if not pre-registered (open from 7am to 8am, no exceptions).
- b. Sign driver waiver form.
- c. Apply wristband to left arm.

# Step 2 -- Prepare your vehicle for Tech Inspection in PADDOCK

- a. Park anywhere in the paddock **EXCEPT** for the first row nearest the track. This row is reserved for **CHIEFS & CREW**
- b. Remove all loose items from the car and store them in your parking spot.
- c. Make sure everything that can be picked up by the wind is weighed down.
- d. Apply class and number magnets to **BOTH** sides of your car.
- e. If you do not have magnets, paper and letter/number templates are available at the Tech Inspection Station.
- f. Please refer to the MotorsportReg attendee list if you don't know your class/car number

# Step 3 -- Tech Inspection @ TECH Inspection Station

- a. If you have your own helmet, keep it in your vehicle for inspection.
  - i. Your helmet must meet current Snell (or equivalent) standards
  - ii. Please refer to the helmet certification standards sheet found at central (CC)
- b. Drive your car to the Tech Inspection Tent (there is usually a line for this).
- c. You must be present while the Tech Inspector checks your vehicle.

#### Step 4 -- Move your vehicle to the correct location

- a. If you are running in the morning, now is a good time to check/adjust your tire **AIR** pressures.
- b. If you are running in Heat 1, park in **GRID A**
- c. If you are running in Heat 2, park in **GRID B**
- d. If you are running Heat 3 or Heat 4, return to the **PADDOCK** 
  - Heat 3 grids in **A**, and Heat 4 grids in **B** in the **AFTERNOON**

## Step 5 -- Walk the COURSE

- a. An announcement will be made when the course is open for walking
- b. Rookie walk begins at **8:15am** (if Rookie class runs in heat 2)
- c. Rookie walk is held during **lunch** if Rookie class runs in the **afternoon**
- d. Driver's meeting starts at **8:45am**, keep track of the time while you are walking the course

## **Rookie FAQ**

- Rookie class graduation requirements (any one of the following, not all)
  - -- Trophied in Run-Off Championship **OR** Points Championship
  - -- 4 events in RK + 850 points average or higher
  - -- 9 events in RK (does not need to be in one season, can finish out season)
- Pit Crew and Support Vehicles
  - -- Each participant is allowed **1 pit crew** and **1 support vehicle**.
  - -- Immediate family is an exception to this rule.
- Entry for **minors** (under 18 years old)
  - -- Parents or legal guardians must complete a form for minors upon entry and are available at the entry gate
